Fulton County Sheriff's Office Arrests Probation Violator

Atlanta, GA – The Fulton County Sheriff's Office, Criminal Investigations Division, Fugitive Apprehension Support Team (FAST) arrested Quatez Elliott, age 26, of College Park, for probation violation and additional warrants. He is currently in the Fulton County Jail.

Elliott was convicted in Fulton County Superior Court for aggravated assault, armed robbery, aggravated stalking, burglary, and cruelty to children in 2023. However, while released on probation, he continued his criminal behavior resulting in additional criminal charges out of the City of South Fulton and Clayton County.

This was a joint effort by FCSO Criminal Investigations Unit, FCSO K9 Unit and federal partners.

“After conviction, this young man was given a second chance by being sentenced to serve probation; however, he chose to continue his criminal behavior,” says Sheriff Patrick “Pat” Labat. “Our office will continue to protect innocent victims of crime and uphold the law and by apprehending those who violate them.”
